

## Resolution 2013-07

## **Front Line Supervisor Training for Ontario Police Officers** Approved at the 62<sup>nd</sup> Annual General Meeting June 2013

**WHEREAS** the Ontario Police College has established itself as a world class training institution, and

**WHEREAS** the Ontario Association of Chiefs of Police supports the Ontario Police College as the police training provider of choice, and

**WHEREAS** the Ontario Police College ensures that standardized, progressive training remains relevant to police services, and

**WHEREAS** the Ontario Police College, in consultation with the OACP Training, Education, and Professional Development Committee, has developed a Front-line Supervisor training course for newly promoted police Supervisors and those serving as Acting Supervisors, and

**WHEREAS** the Ontario Association of Chiefs of Police recognizes the risks inherent in providing supervision to front-line police personnel, and

**WHEREAS** the Adequacy and Effectiveness Standards Regulation sets out a number of standards that guide police practices.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Ontario Association of Chiefs of Police calls on the Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services to develop and enact a supervisory standard by way of regulation to ensure that, at a minimum, all Sergeants and newly confirmed Sergeants complete the accredited Ontario Police College Front-line Supervisor Training.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that any such supervisor training offered outside the Ontario Police College must be consistent with and sanctioned as having met, at minimum, the curriculum course standards as set out in the Ontario Police College Front Line Supervisor Course.
