



## RESOLUTION 2018-02

### Information Sharing Between Police and Non-Police Entities

---

**Preamble:**

Information sharing between police and non-police entities is most often relationship driven and primarily one way – with police receiving information but failing to share information including intelligence about criminal activities, terrorist threats or public safety trends.

**WHEREAS** police agencies are privy to networks of information pertaining to public safety issues; and

**WHEREAS** non-police entities are privy to their own networks of information pertaining to public safety issues; and

**WHEREAS** this information, if shared with police agencies, would increase public safety; and

**WHEREAS** the Criminal Intelligence Service of Ontario has existing systems and structures that could be adapted to manage an information sharing portal for police and non-police entities.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Ontario Association of Chiefs of Police calls upon the Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services to develop a system, portal, and supporting regulations for information sharing between police agencies and non-police agencies in collaboration with the Privacy Commissioner and the Ontario Anti-Discrimination Directorate.
